

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
 "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE OFFICE OF
 TOWNSHIP AUDITOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WINFIELD,
 COUNTY OF UNION, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
 PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A TOWNSHIP
 AUDITOR AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF HIS
 OFFICE, FEES FOR HIS SERVICES AND QUALIFICA-
 TIONS FOR CONSIDERATION FOR SAID OFFICE".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township
 of Winfield:

SECTION 1: That Section 5 of the Ordinance entitled as
 above establishing the office of Township Auditor for the Township of
 Winfield and defining the duties thereof and fixing the salary therefor
 shall be amended to read as follows:

"The Township Auditor shall receive a salary of
 Twelve Hundred (1,200.00) Dollars per annum,
 payable in equal monthly installments for the
 services rendered by him in such capacity".

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances incon-
 sistent herewith are hereby repealed or are amended accordingly.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately
 upon final passage and publication according to law.
